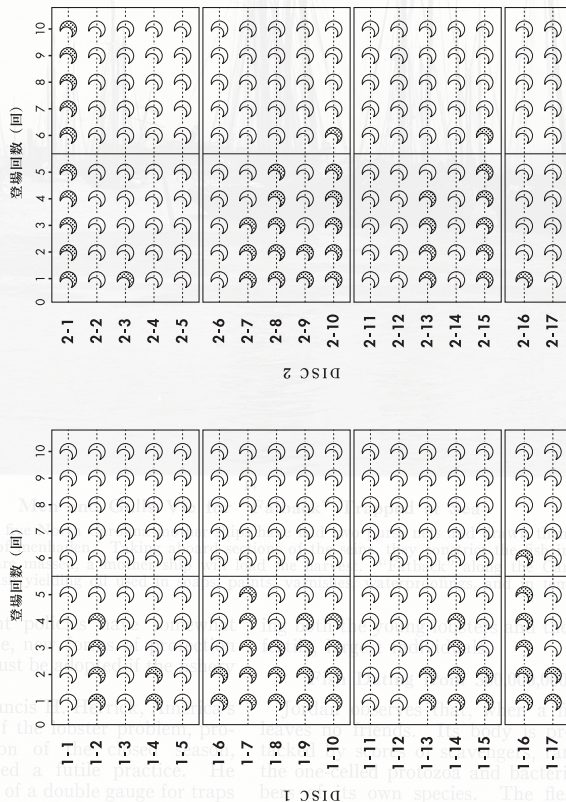

devoured, the gelatinous substance of the bones
decays, leaving the phosphate of lime con-
tent to be absorbed by the water. Hence the
multitudes die without leaving any trace be-
hind. Once in a great while a few teeth, or
a fin spine, or a bone buried in clay may en-
dure, but the exceptions are notably rare.
